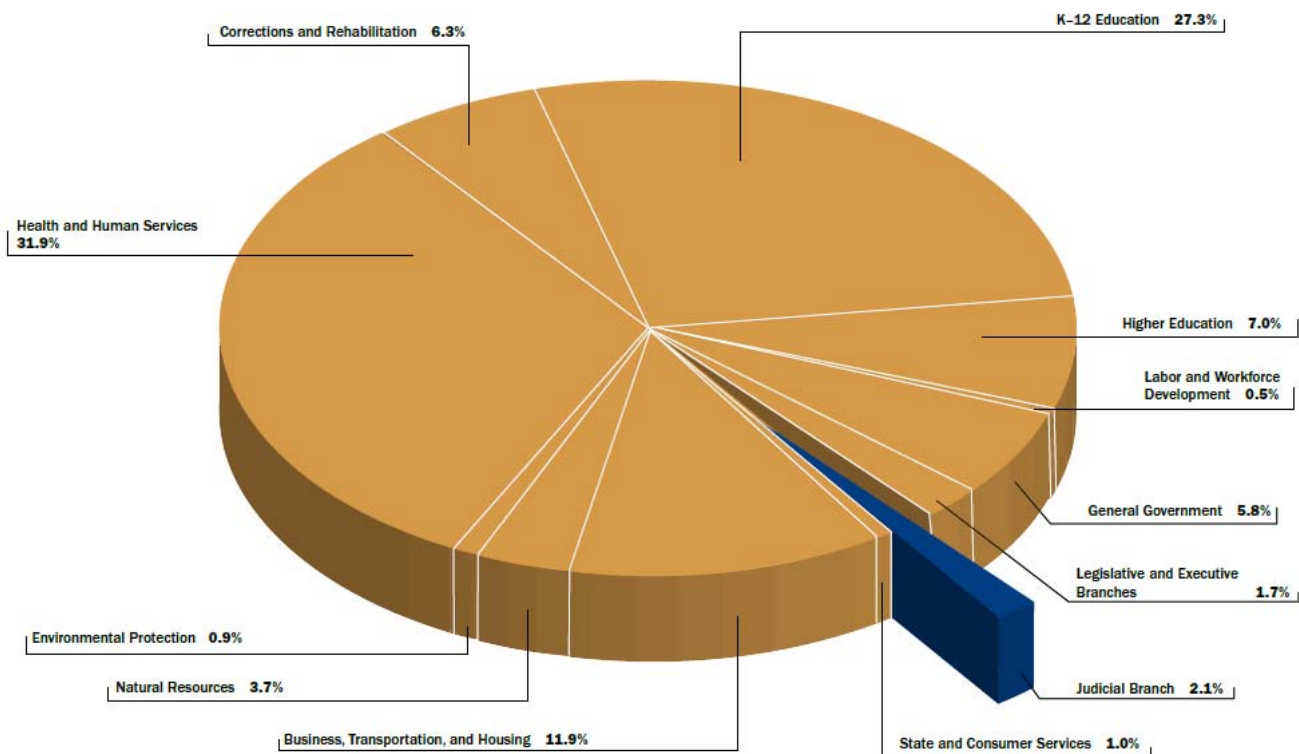

The following charts display the breakdown of the state budget for fiscal year 2012-13 (July 1, 2012 to June 30, 2013) for state level programs as well as by judicial branch entities.

The Judicial Branch Budget Is 2.1% of the Overall State Budget

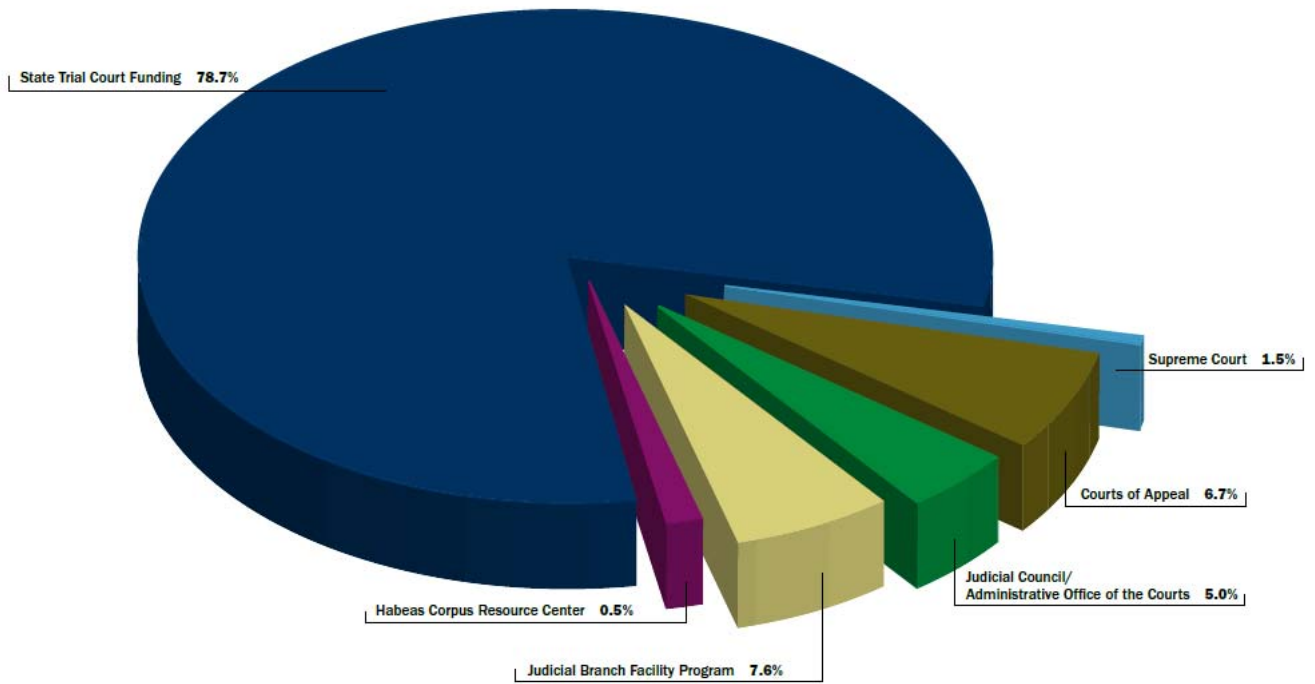


FY 2012-2013 overall State Budget of \$142.4 billion includes General Fund, Special Funds, and Bond Funds. Judicial branch budget is only 0.8% of state General Fund.
