Legend:

- A) Programs Programs are reported by litigation type, jurisdiction, and process type, irrespective of party select or random select (pro bono) designation.
- B) Intakes Includes all cases for which an intake form was received by the ADR Department, from the parties, during the specified period, irrespective of the process type (i.e., arbitration, mediation, neutral evaluation, or voluntary settlement conference) and status (i.e., accepted, rejected, pending).
- C) Cases Opened Includes all cases opened during the specified period, irrespective of the process type. Opening a case in ADR means staff received all required intake paperwork and entered the case in the CMS. This number may include cases in which the initial intake document was received in a previous fiscal year (i.e., June) but not opened (entered into the CMS) until the following fiscal year (i.e., July). Not all of these cases go through an ADR process, they may be settled, dismissed, or removed before the process.
- D) Cases Closed Includes all cases that were closed during the specified period, irrespective of the process type and result. This number may include cases in which the initial intake form was received and/or cases entered into the CMS in a previous fiscal year (i.e., June) but not closed until the following fiscal year (i.e., July). Not all of these cases have been through an ADR process. They may have settled, dismissed, or removed before the process.
- E) Full Agreement or Judgment Includes cases closed during the specified period and that fall into one of the following categories: 1) A mediation, neutral evaluation, or voluntary settlement conference in which the ADR session resulted in a full agreement or 2) An arbitration in which the award of arbitrator was entered as judgment.
- F) Partial Agreement Includes all mediations, neutral evaluations, and voluntary settlement conferences closed during the specified period and in which the ADR session resulted in a partial agreement. A partial agreement may be either a full agreement as to some but not all parties, or a full agreement as to limited issues. This column is not applicable to arbitration.
- G) Non-Agreement or Trial De Novo Includes cases closed during the specified period and that fall into one of the following categories: 1) A mediation, neutral evaluation, or voluntary settlement conference in which the ADR session resulted in a non-agreement or 2) An arbitration in which a trial de novo was filed.
- H) Total Resolved Equals the sum of the Full Agreement or Judgment column (E) and the Partial Agreement column (F).
- I) Cases W/ADR Session & Closing Document Filed Includes all cases in which an ADR session was held and an ADR closing document was filed, irrespective of the process type and result.
- J) Resolution Rate ADR Session Equals the quotient of Total Resolved column (H) divided by Cases W/ADR Session column (I).
