



Some elder care issues we have helped families discuss and resolve:

- ◆ *Living arrangements and abilities:* What are the best living arrangements for an aging parent? Is it safe for the parent to continue to live alone? What level of care, if any, does the parent need now or is likely to need in the future? Is it safe for the parent to continue to drive?
- ◆ *Exploring options:* If living arrangements need to change and/or if it is not safe for the parent to continue driving, what are the family's options and, of those options which is best?
- ◆ *Sharing responsibilities:* What assistance does the parent need and how can adult siblings share responsibilities to enhance an aging parent's life and prevent caregiver burnout?
- ◆ *Rest of Life PlansSM:* Provide a safe environment for an aging loved one to share his/her wishes for the rest of their life and for the end of their life.
- ◆ *Suspicious of physical or financial abuse:* Explore the suspicions and establish how family members can establish trust through accountability and transparency.
- ◆ *Undue influence:* Air and resolve concerns about undue influence over elder or other family members, create action plan for ensuring balance of power.
- ◆ *Communication:* Find the best way for family members to communicate and share information.
- ◆ *Division of assets:* How to divide and/or dispose of assets after a loved one's death.

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
